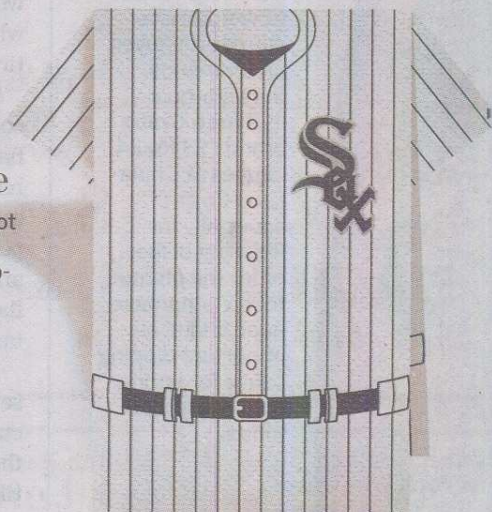
A vote for chocolate
